



# A bunch of flowers

## The workbench

- Paper plates
- Crayons
- Poster paint
- Paint brush
- Scissors
- Thick wire sticks (hardware retailers)
- Foam balls- 1 for each flower
- Glitter
- Tissue paper
- Craft glue
- Tape
- Thin tinsel string

### Step 1.

Mark the middle of the plate with a dot then cut a straight line from the outside of the plate to the dot then cut a circle in the middle of the plate. Using the crayons color the plate with different colors in a zig zag effect, then paint the entire plate front and back, glue on some glitter for a sparkling effect on the flowers.

### Step 2.

Lift one side of the plate over the other side and staple into a cone shape (refer to the picture) then cut 1 inch slits all around the outside of the plate with scissors. Paint the foam balls all over then sprinkle with glitter. Put a line of glue around the inner hole of the plate and push in the foam ball, dry.

### Step 3

Push in a length of thick wire into the base of the foam ball and tape it to the back of the plate to secure. Wrap all of the finished flowers in tissue paper and tie with tinsel string to finish, give them to a very special person.
