

Groovy glasses

The workbench

- Large cereal box or strong cardboard
- Poster paint and brush
- Any type of decorations (buttons, glitter, tinsel, plastic stars, stickers, foam shapes, feathers)
- Colored cellophane
- Tape
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- String or hat elastic
- Tracing paper

Step 1.

Use the tracing paper to trace the pattern at the back of the book then retrace the glasses shape onto the cardboard. Cut out the glasses shape making sure that the eye circles are large enough to see out of and that the frame sides are long enough to go over the ears comfortably.

Step 2.

Paint the glasses and allow some drying time before decorating. Decorate with what ever you have chosen Remember there is no rule to this activity, the crazier the glasses the groovier they'll be. Turn the glasses over once they have been decorated and tape on some cut out cellophane over the eyeholes. Do not put the tape across the eye holes but around the sides for a clearer view.

Step 3.

Put 2 small holes at the ends of the glasses handles and thread through some string or elastic so the glasses stay firmly on the face during play. Put your glasses on and get grooving you did a great job.
