

Hanging spider

The work bench

- 1 large, 1 small foam ball.
- Black poster paint (non toxic) and paint brush
- 24 medium Long tube paper noodles
- White cardboard, plastic push in eyes
- 1 packet feathers
- 1 hat, 8 bells
- 9 pipe cleaners (8 black, 3 red)
- 1 pom pom

Step 1.

Cut up the feathers into fine small pieces. Paint the foam balls and tubes with black paint, then roll them onto the cut feathers. Thread a bell onto one end of each black pipe cleaner, bending it to secure the bell 1cm from the end, then thread 3 feathered tubes onto each black pipe cleaner. With the remaining pipe cleaners other end, bend it over to a 45-degree angle and push it into the large foam ball so the leg dangles downward.

Step 2

Cut out 2 circles from the white cardboard just larger then the plastic eyes and push the plastic eyes through them. Push the eyes into the small foam ball, glue on the pom pom nose (optional).

Step 3.

Cut the red pipe cleaner in half to shape a mouth then bend the ends over and push into the foam to secure. Cut a red pipe cleaner into 3 equal pieces then push half of the 3 pipe cleaners into the small head. Push the head onto the body so that other half of the pipe cleaners push into the body until it is secure. Place the hat on the head and with the remaining pipe cleaner bend it in half and push the ends into the body until secure to hang your spider.
