

Life size twin

The workbench

- Poster paint and brush
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Self laminating sheet
- Wire pads
- 2 pipe cleaners or string for shoe laces
- Wire and beads for necklace
- Colored paper various colors
- Large photo of kids face (to fit A4 sheet)
- Large cardboard sheet to fit kids body up to the neck (electrical retailers)

Step 1.

Lay the child on top of the cardboard length then trace around the body including the neck, but not the head. Cut out the body shape using scissors.

Draw on the shorts, top and shoes then cut up the colored paper into shapes and glue them onto the shorts area (refer to the picture) then cut away any over hanging paper.

Step 2.

Place a piece of colored paper underneath the top and bottom of the body and trace out a shirt and shoes, and then glue onto the body. Decorate the shirt with paint using the wire pad and paint the arms, legs and neck with an appropriate paint color to match the color of the child's skin.

Step 3.

Make 2 holes in the snickers side by side and thread string or pipe cleaners through for laces. Place the photo inside the laminating sheet and cut the face out; then glue it onto the neck area leaving to dry completely. Thread beads onto the wire and tie around the neck for a necklace.
