



Paper flower picture

The workbench

- Pink, red, purple, yellow, dark and light green tissue paper
- Dark and light blue paper
- PVA glue
- Buttons
- Colored markers in the same colors as the tissue paper
- Scissors
- Paint brush
- Large white cardboard sheet

Note to parents: for children under 6 years old, have everything pre cut, for e.g. cut up the paper and scrunch up tissue paper, little ones love doing this activity but will loose interest after doing the preparation needed to start the fun stuff. Also keep the flowers more simple and larger so they can manage it easier.

Step 1.

Draw a flowerpot and some flowers; then with the colored markers, roughly color the flowers in. This is so the children can follow where they should place the corresponding tissue paper colors.

Step 2.

Rip the tissue paper into small pieces and scrunch into balls then glue them to the matching colors on the picture.

Step 3.

Cut up the blue paper into different size pieces and glue around the flowers and pot then glue the buttons onto the center of the flowers, and allow the picture to dry completely, before hanging on the wall.
