

# Rocket ship



Ingredients required:

Coloured light weight card sheet

Toilet roll inner

Tape

Craft glue

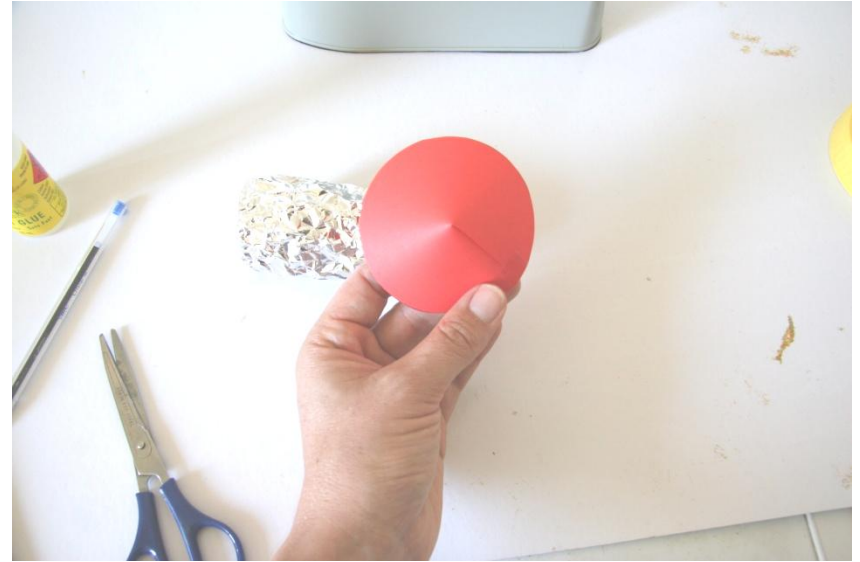
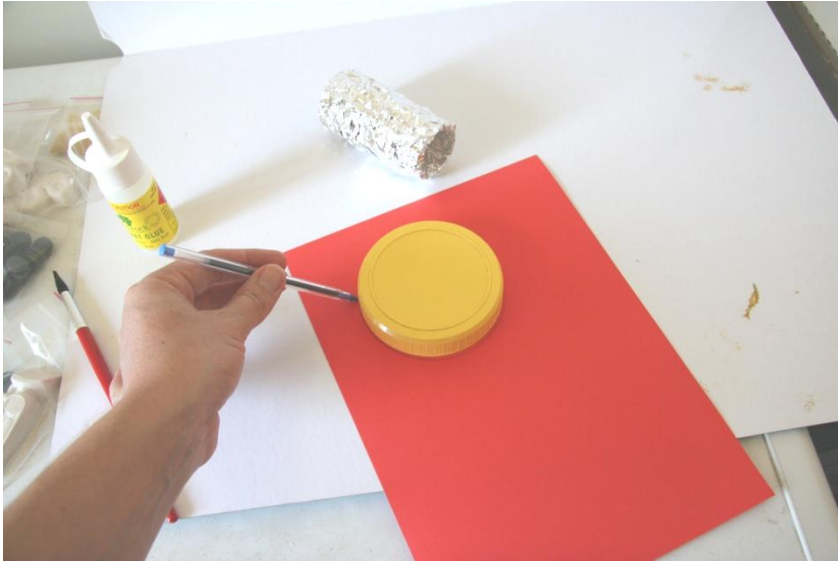
Tissue paper

Foil

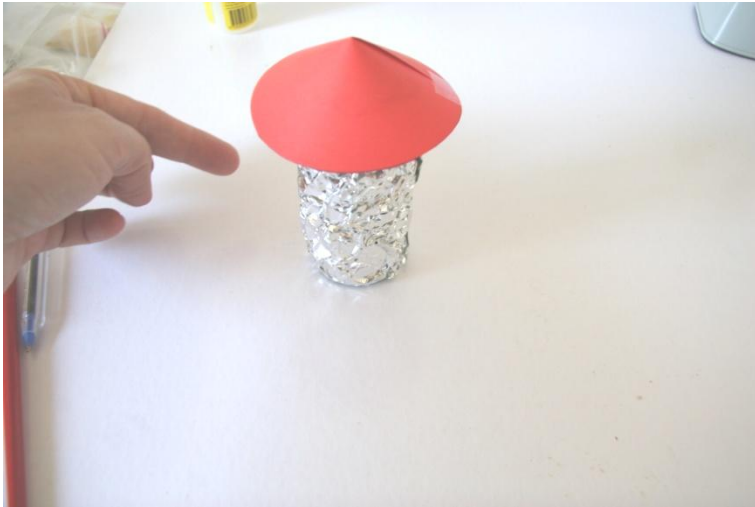
Paper ribbon



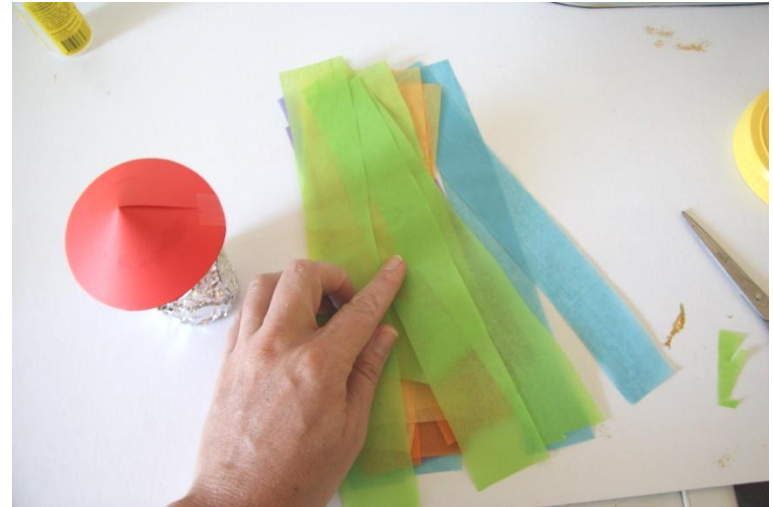
Scrunch up foil rectangle lightly and roll around toilet roll, trim the ends and tuck ends inside the roll to secure.



Using a lid of sorts that is bigger than the size circle on the end of the toilet roll e.g a breakfast spread jar lid, I used a vegemite lid, trace a circle onto a sheet of colour card. Cut out the circle, find the centre of the circle and cut from the circles outside into that centre point. Gently shape the circle so that one cut edge overlaps the other cut edge so it makes a cone shape, tape into place.



Place a good layer of craft glue around the outer edge of the toilet roll inner and attached the card cone over it and allow to dry.



Cut tissue paper in strips.



Cut ribbon and curl it with a pair of scissors. Add ribbon and tissue paper to the inside of the toilet roll inner at the bottom end, glue into place. This projects need craft glue because of its tacky nature and fast drying action.

Scrunch up foil into a ball just smaller than the opening left after placing tissue paper and ribbon in, add glue and add the foil ball to plug the opening hole and secure in tissue paper into place.

Up up and away!
